

# What to do if you are told that your child has been unkind

## Be brave:

- Listen to others' views, not just your child's account.
- Explain how we have to take responsibility for our actions and that bullying is always unacceptable.
- Discuss how we can work as a community to rebuild relationships.

## Be kind:

- Listen, reassure and respond.
- Explain how bullying and/or conflict can affect others.
- Discuss how to treat others with respect.

## Be you:

- Advise your child to stop and work with the community to rebuild relationships.
