

What to do if your child is being bullied

Be brave:

- Discuss the difference between conflict and bullying.
- Do not tell your child to retaliate or remain silent.

Be kind:

- Reassure them it's not their fault.
- Tell them that bullying is unacceptable and will not be tolerated.
- Listen, reassure and respond.

Be you:

- Advise your child to stop, speak and report to a trusted adult.
- Contact the school to discuss how we can work as a community to rebuild relationships.
- Above all, if your child is being bullied remember to stop, speak and report to a trusted adult.
